In 1961, we became a bonafide grape grower with the first planting of Chasselas. In 1989 we opened our winery doors, Quails' Gate Estate Winery. In 1999 we opened a seasonal dining patio, Old Vines Patio. In 2005, we expanded our onsite dining experience to include a newly renovated, year round dining restaurant, Old Vines Restaurant. This year our family celebrates fifty years at our home site.
